Extra-Curricular Activities

*Clubs provided by external providers (Tennis and Judo) are offered to one year group at a time. Once a year group has completed a 5 or 6 week block, we invite another year group to take part. We aim to offer each club to as many year groups as possible during the academic year.

Judo

Throughout the year, we offer an after school Judo club. It is run by JE –Judo Education, who have over 22 years of experience providing Judo in schools and currently work with 800 schools in the North West of England. Wirral. The club takes place on Monday evenings. Pupils have fun, learn new skills and also learn about respect and discipline. The cost of a 5 week block of sessions is £26.



Homework



Throughout the year, we offer after school homework clubs for Year 5 and Year 6 pupils. The clubs are run by our Year 5 and Year 6 teachers and take place on a Thursday evening in our classrooms. The clubs provide pupils with the opportunity to complete homework tasks at a desk in a quiet environment whilst having access to teachers should they have any questions or require any help. There is no cost to join the club.

Tennis

Throughout the year, we offer an after school Tennis club. It is run by coaches from Tennis Vision who are based at Prenton Lawn Tennis Club. The club takes place on Wednesday evenings. Tennis Vision offer lots of opportunities for children to continue playing when their block of sessions comes to an end. They have holiday camps, Fun Friday sessions and invite pupils to become a full time members at Prenton Tennis Club. The cost of a 5 week block of sessions is £15.



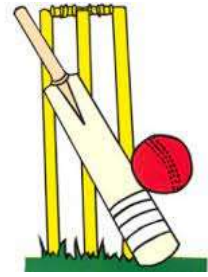
French



At different intervals in the year, we offer an after school French club run by KS2 teachers. The club takes place on Thursday evenings. Pupils have lots of fun as they learn the basics of the French language such as simple conversations, colours, family members and food. There is no cost to join the club.

Cricket

In the summer term, we offer an after school cricket club run by KS2 teachers. The club takes place on Thursday evenings. Pupils have lots of fun as they learn the basics of this wonderful sport and some of the pupils will be selected to represent the school at inter school competitions. There is no cost to join the club.



Cookery



We offer an after school cookery club in the autumn term and summer term run by our staff. Pupils learn new skills, have fun and produce some delicious food! The cost for a 4 week block of sessions is approximately £5. This payment allows Mrs Thomas to purchase all the necessary ingredients.

Football

Throughout the academic year, we offer a Year 5 Football club and a Year 6 club that takes place on Tuesday and Thursday lunchtimes. Pupils are encouraged to develop their footballing skills as well as developing their teamwork, resilience and sportsmanship. Pupils who attend may be selected to represent the school in inter school competitions. To be selected, pupils must show their footballing ability and an excellent attitude within school. There is no cost to join the club.



Stoolball



In the summer term, we organise a Key Stage 2 Stoolball competition. Pupils from Year 3 to Year 6 join together to form teams and the competition takes place over a number of weeks. ! The matches take place at lunchtimes. For those unfamiliar with the sport, it is a cross between cricket and rounders. It is known as 'cricket in the air'. Guitar

Our Year 5 and year 6 pupils, have the opportunity to attend Guitar Club run by an external provider. This takes place during the school day. Pupils really enjoy learning the basics of the instrument and developing their rhythm as well as having a creative outlet.



Dance



KS1 and KS2 are invited to join an after school Dance Club run by our teachers. We work with the pupils to develop their rhythm and build fun routines. The club is great for building pupils' confidence. There is no cost to join this club.

Art

KS1 and KS2 staff provide an after school Art Club for pupils in KS1 and KS2. There is a small cost to join the club as they use lots of exciting art resources. The pupils develop a wide range of art skills and work with confidence to produce impressive art pieces.



Cycling



Throughout the year, we run an after school cycling club called Prenton Peddlers! We work with the pupils on a 1:3 ratio to develop basic cycling skills. The club is not designed for pupils who can ride. It is for those pupils who are yet to master the basics and cannot ride independently.

Tag Rugby

In the summer term, we run a lunchtime Tag Rugby Club for year 6 pupils. There is no cost for taking part in the club. Pupils work with great enthusiasm to develop their rugby skills as well as developing life skills such as determination and team spirit.



Mini Bootcamp



In the summer term, KS1 staff run an after school Mini Bootcamp Club for F2 pupils. The pupils complete a series of activities that foster the importance of being fit and healthy and build pupils' balance, coordination and agility. There is no cost in joining the club.

Knitting

KS2 pupils are invited in the autumn term to join our Knitting Club. Pupils develop their knitting skills, make impressive finished products and the club offers the opportunity to participate in a calming activity that is known to have be good for pupils' mindfulness.



Cross Country



Throughout the year, we organise a Cross Country Club for year 5 and year 6 pupils. Pupils work with great enthusiasm to develop their running skills as well as developing life skills such as determination and resilience. There is no cost to join the club. Some pupils are selected to represent the school in the Wirral Cross Country Championships.

Creative Club

For two terms of the year, KS1 staff organise an after school Creative Club for KS1 pupils. The pupils produce a range of art and crafts based products and thoroughly enjoy being creative and getting messy! Paint and glitter is never far away! There is a small cost to join the club to cover the cost of buying resources.
