and Language**



- To answer how and why questions in response to Augustus and his Smile.
- To use past and present forms accurately when talking about events that have happened.
- To develop their own narratives through telling their own stories.
- To listen to stories and express views about events or characters.

This half-term we shall be looking at the story 'Augustus and his Smile' by Catherine Rayner. The book will be our stimulus for learning across all areas of the Early Years Curriculum.



Physical Development

We will begin a formal PE lesson in this Summer Term.

- The children will be showing good control and co-ordination in large and small movements.
- The children will move confidently, safely negotiating space.
- The children will hold the pencil with the correct pencil grip and be able to write letters of a legible size.

Writing



- The children will be using descriptive language to describe and write about the tiger.
- They will be retelling the story in the correct sequence, using story language.
- The children will write their own story and adventures of tigers.
- We will be writing questions and facts about tigers.

Summer Term 1

Mathematics

- They will be adding together groups of animals and finding total amounts up to 20. 
- They will be taking away different amount of animals.
- We will be looking at and comparing money for our Zoo and Pet Shop.
- The children will be consolidating their number recognition and ordering to 20.

Understanding the World



- To use technology to research facts about tigers.
- To talk about past and present events that have made them feel happy or sad in their own lives.
- We will be comparing similarities and differences between animals around the world.

This half-term we will be visiting Knowsley Safari Park for the day. This will include a safari drive, watching the sea-lion show and taking part in a Safari Workshop.
